§2. Early Encounters

Before excavations in Jaffa began in 1947, exploration and documentation of Jaffa's cultural heritage consisted almost exclusively of traveler and pilgrim accounts, military records of European powers, and the accounts of early explorers in the nineteenth century.

§2.3. Early Exploration, 1800–1947

Prior to modern archaeological work, exploration of Jaffa took place against the backdrop of increasing interest in the Holy Land. Because Jaffa was predominantly identified as a port of entry, it was of passing interest to most scholars, and for this reason, reference to its archaeological and material remains was limited.

§7. Abu Kabir

About 2 km to the east of Jaffa is Abu Kabir, the location of a Jewish cemetery presumably belonging to Jaffa during the Roman and Byzantine periods. While the dominant information for the site derives from analysis of inscriptions associated with the burial complexes, there have also been published several excavation reports and studies integrating the site within syntheses on this subject (see esp. Ecker 2010 and forthcoming report in O. Tsuf volume on Jaffa).
